Abed Itani and Darrell Robinson explained the FY2017/2020 TIP. Under federal law a new TIP has to be developed every four years. All the public involvement work has been done. This document covers the urban as well as rural TIP. The full document is available online. \$246 million will be spent over the next four years which includes a 2% increase in funds per year. Almost every member of the MPO received a project.

Abed Itani reported on the UPWP activities and budget. GVMC has met with MDOT and Federal Highway and all requirements have been included in the program. It includes a 2% increase over the previous year. The document is available on line. Transportation dues will remain the same as last year, as will MPO staffing. The plan has already been approved by the Policy and Tech committees.

6. Amendment to FY2016 Unified Planning Work Program for ITP

Abed Itani explained the requested amendment to the FY2016 Unified Planning Work Program for ITP to reflect additional FTA Section 5303, transit planning funds. ITP is requesting to add a regional study to determine the Locally Preferred Alternative (LPA) for a 3rd Bus Rapid Transit Corridor. The total project cost is estimated at \$437,500 with FTA share of \$350,000 and State share of \$87,500.

7. Port of Muskegon Presentation

Erin Kuhn of WMSRDC and Mark Eisenbarth of Muskegon County presented on the Port of Muskegon. Included in the presentation was its history, the closing of the Cobb Energy plant and the campaign to increase shipping through Muskegon. Initial funds from the RPI grant helped to jumpstart the effort, resulting in considerable local, state and federal match.

An amendment to the Port Authority Act through SB5651 is needed to allow for public / private partnerships in Port Authorities. GVMC members were asked to support needed legislative changes to continue the effort.

8. Other

Brenda McNabb-Stang reported on SB438 regarding solar energy and encouraged members to notify their legislators regarding their positions.

Also reported on was a package of bills to amend PA85 to allow locals to set speed limits without strictly adhering to the current 85% rule. MML is in support of the legislation.
