# Resolution to Amend Council Bylaws to Change Required Number of Monthly Meetings of the Council

WHEREAS, the Bylaws of the Council provide at Section 1.2 that the Council shall meet regularly at least once a month; and

WHEREAS, the Members of the Council desire to reduce such number of required monthly meetings.

# IT IS, THEREFORE, RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 1.2 of the Council Bylaws is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:
  - 1.2 <u>Meetings; Notice</u>. The Council shall meet regularly in at least four (4) meetings in each calendar year at locations determined by the Council. The Chairperson or a majority of the Members of the Council may call a special meeting of the Council provided that at least twenty-four (24) hours' notice of the meeting is given to Members of the Council. The notice shall state the place, time and purpose of the special meeting. Except for the provisions of this section,

special meetings are subject to the same rules as regular meetings. No special or regular meeting may be conducted without a quorum as provided in the Articles.

This Resolution amends the Council Bylaws only as stated above. All other

provisions of t	he Bylaws remain in effect according to their terms.
3.	This Resolution shall be effective at the time it is adopted by the Council.

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# **MEMORANDUM**

Re: Draft 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan

GVMC Staff has completed the first draft of our 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP), which can be viewed on the GVMC website at <a href="www.gvmc.org/mtp">www.gvmc.org/mtp</a>. At their joint Committee meeting on January 15, the Technical and Policy Committees unanimously approved this draft to move forward with the official public comment and review period.

The draft 2045 MTP document represents months of work and includes input from Committee members, stakeholders, and the public. GVMC staff have brought many elements of the draft document to the Technical and Policy Committees over the last several months, including:

- Updated socioeconomic data for use in our new travel demand model
- A revised vision statement, goals, and objectives for the MTP
- The results of the comprehensive mode-based needs and deficiencies analysis, which included the integration of new performance-based planning requirements
- The MTP project list

# The following was also accomplished:

- A public survey to gauge transportation priorities for regional users
  - 867 survey responses including 534 written comments
- A financial analysis to determine the following projected funding levels through 2045
  - \$557.6 million in federal funding for local programs
  - \$5.7 billion in local funding
  - \$3.4 billion in state funding
  - \$4 billion in transit funding from all transit fund sources
- An environmental justice analysis and environmental mitigation analysis for the project list
- Consultation on the draft project list (one comment received indicating support of the project lists)

Public involvement opportunities have been continuous throughout the development of the MTP, and an official public comment opportunity for the public to review and comment on the draft MTP will be held from February 1 – March 2. There will also be a public meeting on February 10 at Rapid Central Station during the public comment period.

At the March meetings, the Technical and Policy Committees will again be asked to approve the draft document, which will be updated to include feedback received during the public comment period and/or minor editorial changes. GVMC staff plans to bring the 2045 MTP to the GVMC Board for final approval on May 7, 2020.
