6. REGIS Rebate

For the past 6 years REGIS has rebated its members a total of \$750,000. This year \$100,000 is requested to be rebated with each community receiving a share equal to their percentage of the total dues. The REGIS Executive Committee and Board have already approved the rebate.

REGIS and Environmental Programs budgets have been approved by their respective committees. Everything is going extremely well.
